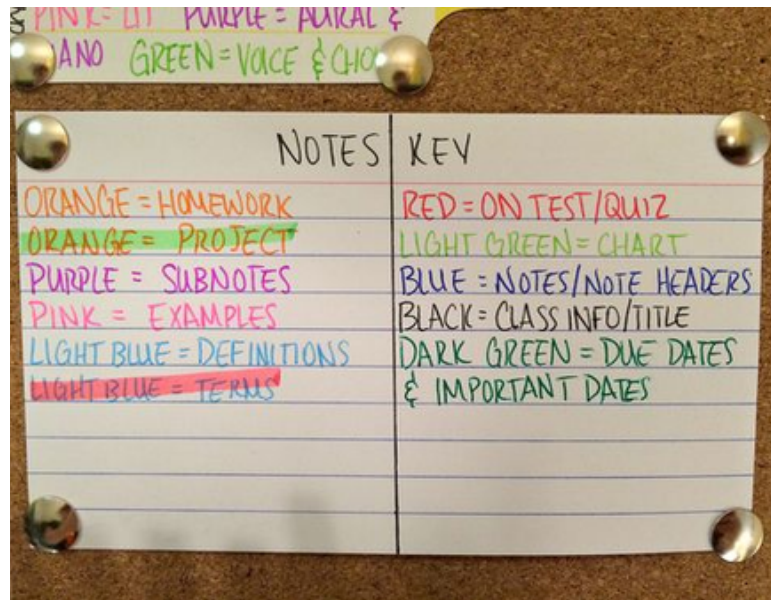

Colour Coding

What is it?

- Colour coding is a system in which colours can be used to represent and organise information.
- It can be used as a memory strategy. Memory supports Planning and Organisation.



How to use it

- Consider what the student needs to organise and establish a few organisational categories.
- Assign each category a colour (e.g. class subject categories)
- Gather materials for colour coding. These might be coloured folders to place on a bookshelf or simply pieces of coloured tape to stick on filing cabinet drawers.
