Subject Containers

What is it?

A container that holds items including stationary and books required for a particular lesson. Each lesson could have a different colour subject container.

How to use it



- Use visuals/words or both to label each box.
- Read the support used together to check understanding.
- Encourage the pupil to independently locate the box using the colour or words as a prompt. “Find the blue box for maths”
- Keep the box in the same area of the classroom.



Example

Maths lesson subject container may be a blue box, and contain:

- Maths class book
- Pencil
- Rubber
- Ruler
- Counting cubes
- Number line



Colour plays a significant role in enhancing memory performance. Colour increases the chance for environmental stimuli to be understood, stored, and retrieved successfully.
